- Entries close: Midnight Friday 15 March 2024
- A consolation event will be held for each championship event for participants who lose their first match in the event.
- Refer to the Tournament website for your playing schedule which should be available by Thursday 21 March, and will be regularly updated.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The **Tournament Committee** ("Committee") shall have complete control of the Tournament.
- 2. Entry to the tournament is restricted to **financial members** (all categories except social members) of Bullcreek Tennis Club (Inc.) ("Club").
- 3. The Committee reserves the right to **refuse entry** of any player.
- 4. The Committee reserves the right to **cancel** any event if there are insufficient entries and entry fees will be refunded if this occurs.
- 5. All competitors under 18 must have the consent of their parent/s or legal guardian upon entering.
- 6. By entering competitors consent to **photographs** being taking of them during the tournament. Those photos will be used to promote the event and may be used by the local media.
- 7. Every competitor must enter online or by using the official **entry form**. Entry forms are to be emailed to bullcreektennisclubevents@outlook.com or placed in an envelope and either handed to the Club Captain or placed in the locked suggestion box in the clubhouse.
- 8. Entry fees not paid with entry or by EFT **must be paid** prior to playing first match.
- 9. Competitors may enter doubles events **without partners** and the Committee will endeavour to find a suitable partner. If a partner is not found fees paid for that event will be refunded.
- 10. Junior competitors may play in four (4) events and up to two (2) events may be singles.
- 11. Entries received after the closing date will not be accepted.
- 12. All competitors must be **available to play** from 8.00am each day. Exemptions requested will be considered by the tournament committee.
- 13. Competitors must report to the tournament office 15 minutes prior to the commencement of their matches irrespective of the weather. Competitors who are late for matches may be forfeited.
- 14. The draw and schedule will be available on the official tournament web site.
- 15. **Seeding** will be at the discretion of the Committee.
- 16. In knockout format events players who lose their first match are eligible for consolation events.
- 17. Play shall be continuous. Warm ups will be limited to 5 minutes, change of ends will be limited to 1 minute and 30 seconds, no more than 25 seconds between points, and no more than 5 minutes for injury time. Any incidents requiring **injury time** must be brought to the attention of the Committee.
- 18. Should the **temperature** reach or exceed 37 degrees Celsius (per BOM site) play will be suspended immediately and only resume once the temperature drops below that level.
- 19. **Match formats** will depend on the event.
 - Senior Championship, Junior Open and 15&U matches will be best of two (2) tie-breaker sets with a Match Tie-Break Game (to 10 points) at one (1) set all.
 - Championship, Open and 15&U Consolation events will be a first to nine (9) games Pro Set with a match tie- breaker (to 10 points) at 8-all.
 - 13&U matches will be best of three (3) Fast 4 sets, with a tie-breaker at 3 all.
 - 13&U Consolation matches will be best of 2 Fast 4 sets with a Fast 4 tie-breaker (to 5) at 1 set all.
- 20. New balls will be provided at the discretion of the Committee.
- 21. The codes of behaviour and conduct approved by Tennis Australia and Tennis West will apply and will be displayed at the courts. The Referee may impose penalties in accordance with each code. In the event of any disputes the Committee's decision shall be final.
- 22. All **disputes** involving the rules or laws of tennis must be referred to the Committee whose decision shall be final.
- 23. No **coaching** or advice, except from a doubles partner during a doubles match, will be permitted. Any breach may result in the player being defaulted and the offending spectator being removed from the vicinity of the courts.
- 24. The Committee reserves the right to reduce the **length of matches** and/or **play matches under lights** should conditions require it.
- 25. The Committee may provide chair **umpires** for Championship finals and for other matches as decided by the Committee.
- 26. **Trophies/prizes** will be presented to winners and runners-up of Championship events as well as winners of Consolation events.
