- A consolation (plate) event will be held for each championship event for participants who lose their first match in the event.
- **Entries close: Midnight Friday 1st April.**

- The **match schedule** will be emailed and available from Thursday 7th April on the tournament web site and in the tournament box window of the clubhouse.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The **Tournament Committee** ("Committee") shall have complete control of the Tournament.
2. Entry to the tournament is restricted to **financial members** (all categories except social members) of Bullcreek Tennis Club (Inc.) ("Club").
3. The Committee reserves the right to **refuse entry** of any player.
4. The Committee reserves the right to **cancel** any event if there are insufficient entries and entry fees will be refunded if this occurs.
5. All competitors **under 18** must have the consent of their parent/s or legal guardian upon entering.
6. By entering competitors consent to **photographs** being taking of them during the tournament. Those photos will be used to promote the event and may be used by the local media.
7. Every competitor must enter using the official **entry form**. Entry forms can be placed in the locked suggestion box in the clubhouse or received by mail or email by the stated closing date. Entry fees not accompanying the entry form **must be paid** prior to playing first match.
8. Competitors may enter **without partners** and the Committee will endeavour to find a suitable partner. If a partner is not found fees paid for that event will be refunded.
9. Junior competitors may play in four (4) events and up to two (2) events may be singles.
10. Entries received after the **closing date** will not be accepted.
11. All competitors must be **available to play** from 8.30am Saturday and 8.30am on Sunday. Exemptions of up to 1 day in total (excluding Sunday 17th April) must be made with the Entry.
12. Competitors must also report to the tournament office 15 minutes prior to the commencement of their matches irrespective of the weather. Competitors who are late for matches may be forfeited.
13. The **schedule** for each weekend's play will be displayed in the tournament box window of the clubhouse by Thursday of that week. The draw and schedule will also be available on the official tournament web site.
14. **Seeding** will be at the discretion of the Committee.
15. Seeded players who get a **bye** in the first round will be ineligible for plate events.
16. In events that have a knockout format any competitor who is forfeited in the first round may not be eligible for plate events.
17. Play shall be continuous. Warm ups will be limited to 5 minutes, change of ends will be limited to 1 minute and 30 seconds, no more than 30 seconds between points, and no more than 5 minutes for injury time. Any incidents requiring **injury time** must be brought to the attention of the Committee.
18. Should the **temperature** reach or exceed 37 degrees Celsius play will be suspended immediately and only resume once the temperature drops below that level.
19. **Match formats** will depend on the event. Senior Open Championship matches will be best of three (3) tie-breaker sets. Plate events and 12&U matches will be first to nine (9) games with a match tie-breaker at 8-all. 14&U and Junior Open matches will be best-of-two sets with a match tie-breaker at one (1) set all.
20. **Hard courts** will be used for all main draw events with the exception of some first round doubles and mixed matches which may be allocated to the clay courts. Both hard and clay courts will be used for plate events at the discretion of the Committee.
21. **New balls** will be provided at the discretion of the Committee.
22. The codes of behaviour and conduct approved by Tennis Australia and Tennis West will apply and will be displayed at the courts. The Referee may impose penalties in accordance with each code. In the event of any disputes the Committee's decision shall be final.
23. All **disputes** involving the rules or laws of tennis must be referred to the Committee whose decision shall be final.
24. No **coaching** or advice, except from a doubles partner during a doubles match, will be permitted. Any breach may result in the player being defaulted and the offending spectator being removed from the vicinity of the courts.
25. The Committee reserves the right to reduce the **length of matches** and/or **play matches under lights** should conditions require it.
26. The Committee may provide chair **umpires** for Championship finals and for other matches as decided by the Committee.
27. **Trophies/prizes** will be presented to winners and runners-up of Championship events as well as winners of plate events.
